From the eighteenth century on, natural Science and Religion: A Contemporary Perspective, such as de Maillet, Lamarck, Chambers, and Darwin, proposed transmutationist what would now be called evolutionary theories, which seem incompatible with scriptural interpretations of the special creation of species. Moreover, it is in being faithful to its legitimate role and function as an academic discipline and not through usurping the function of religion and laying claim as the science of reality that science will be conscious of its real value. In their Anthropic Cosmological Principle Barrow and Tipler list ten steps in the evolution of homo sapiens including such steps as the development of the DNA-based genetic code, the origin of mitochondria, the origin of photosynthesis, the development of aerobic respiration, and so forth, each of which is so improbable that before it would have occurred, the sun would have ceased to be a main sequence star and incinerated the earth.
