Though there are separate blessings for fruit, vegetables, non-bread grain products, and meat, fish, and Simple Graces for Every Meal products, a meal is not considered to be a meal in the formal sense unless bread is eaten. The ritual washing of hands and eating of salted bread is considered to be a substitute for the sacrificial offerings of the kohanim Jewish priests.
